## **ESTIMATED COST OF PARTICIPATION**

1 Programme Fee

The international summer school fee ranges from £2,150 for a 2-week programme (either block one or block two) to £3,900 for an entire 4-week programme (block 1 + block 2).

The summer school fees cover the following:

- Tuition

- Breakfast and lunch (Mondays to Fridays)
- Module field trips
- Weekend excursions
- Social activities
