### **PROGRAMME DETAILS**

## Academic Content

Students can study with the International Summer School for a period of either three or six weeks. You will choose three modules to study during each threeweek period.

Modules are grouped by session – weeks 1-3 or 4-6 – and split into four categories: A, B, C and D. Students will choose three modules per 3-week session, selecting from 3 different categories. (For example, you will not be able to take two modules from category A.) This is to ensure there are no timetable clashes

10	Course Mapping	All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.
		If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.
		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.
