Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</li> <li>Of the units approved for mapping, a total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to NUS Special Term fees.
