Due to the COVID-19 situation, University of Liverpool has made the decision to move the International Summer School online.

Students may apply for module mapping and transfer a maximum of eight (8) MCs (this is applicable only to electronic summer programmes 2021). Please note that some Schools or Faculties (including School of Computing) will not approve module mapping for remote or online courses. Please check with your home School or Faculty Dean's Office to determine if module mapping can be approved for remote/online courses before applying to the partner university.

Applying through EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen). Read the step-by-step guide which we have prepared for you on GRO's web.</p> <p>Please note that you must accept <u>both</u> the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer in order to confirm your participation in this programme.</p>
