You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Regarding the Berkeley application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Refer to this registration guide on how to register as an affiliated student to enjoy early enrolment. Take advantage of the early enrolment benefit because popular classes can fill up quickly. 2. Read through the sections of Berkeley's website regarding Fees, Refund Policy, Deadlines, and Academic Policies. 3. Research the courses from the Class Schedule and write down the five-digit class number of the courses you'd like to attend. 4. Apply for Summer Sessions. 5. After you apply, follow the instructions on this checklist to create your UC Berkeley login, enroll in your chosen courses, pay tuition, and prepare for your time in Berkeley. <p>To know when the session start and end dates are as well as application and registration deadlines, visit Berkeley's website below. 		summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. Students should inquire with the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department on being considered for a fee waiver.
