8	Module Mapping	<p>You can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each summer programme. A total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. Students should inquire with the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department on being considered for a fee waiver. 9	Vaccination & Immunisation Requirement	<p>Yale University requires anyone who enrolls at Yale to provide proof of immunizations. Students will not be permitted to enroll in classes until all the forms are submitted and the immunization requirements are met. Some immunization requirements may take a month or more to complete so early planning is essential.</p> <p>Please read and pay close attention to all the requirements and deadlines listed here. Failure to comply may result in you not being able to register for classes.</p>

This is comprehensive health insurance for the duration of the program. Visiting students will also be billed a Yale Health usage fee and may use the Yale Health Center for minor medical problems.
