D.	Exchange Duration	One semester
E.	Course Information	Exchange students must take a minimum of 18 credit points or 24 credit points per semester. Most units (courses) are worth six points, so this generally works out to three or four units per semester.  Please note that the maximum workload is 24 credit points per semester.  The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 24 credit points. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. G.	Visa	Once you have purchased the Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC), your host university will issue an Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE), which is required for your Australian student visa application.  All exchange students must hold a current visa which entitles them to study for the full duration of their programme. Typically, this is a subclass 500 student visa and student should obtain the visa before arriving in Australia.

Students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they
received the official offer letter/email from their host university. This is to
ensure that you can obtain your visa in time before the start of your
exchange term. Your exchange at the host university depends on the
clearance by the immigration of the host country.

All visas are subject to conditions and students must ensure they always comply with the conditions of their visa.

All international students studying in Australia are required to purchase an approved Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) policy. OSHC is compulsory requirement for obtaining an Australian subclass 500 (student) visa. Students can purchase OSHC through your host university.
