<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>On-campus housing is limited and not guaranteed for exchange students. Students are advised to apply as early as possible after they receive their Invitation to Apply. <p>Visa</p>	<p>Exchange students who study for one semester only (less than 6 months) are not required to apply for a study permit. However, depending on your country of citizenship, you may have to apply for an eTA OR a visitor visa.</p> <p>For more information on visa applications, please refer to https://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp.</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university’s Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/.</p> <p>UCalgary expect exchange students to have a comprehensive travel and medical insurance. Students should purchase insurance from their home country that covers the full duration of their stay in Canada.</p> <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Canada. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.</p> <p>Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>
