Language Proficiency Requirement	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (with limited English-taught courses). NUS students with Chinese language background will be considered for Chinese-taught courses by providing the highest level of Chinese language certificate with result.
Course Information	<p>The credit hours and workload requirements vary with different programmes at Chongqing University. Students could visit http://study.cqu.edu.cn to find the programmes available and contact admissions@cqu.edu.cn if they need more information.</p> <p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 13 credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.</p>
Accommodation	<p>International Students may live on campus at the Songlinpo International Student Apartment or Xuelin International Student Apartment in campus A or No. 6 Orchid Building International Students Dormitory in campus D.</p> <p>Self-funded international students can choose to apply for residence in international student dormitories on campus or rent off-campus on their own. Visa	<p>Exchange students are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).</p> <p>You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202) once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme. Exchange students from Singapore are required to apply for the student visa in person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.</p> <p>For information on visa application, please refer to https://www.visaforchina.cn/</p>
Insurance	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance.
