Application	Non-Chinese nationality preferred; Chinese national applicants are
Requirement	accepted but there is no provision of on-campus housing
Language Proficiency Requirement	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (limited English-taught courses). NUS students with Chinese language background are exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency requirements to read Chinese-taught courses at Fudan University.
Course Information	Exchange students are required to read 6-15 credits at Fudan University for one semester (equivalent to 2-8 courses).
	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 13 credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.
	Course Restrictions: MBA courses and Undergraduate-level courses in basic medical sciences, clinical medicine and nursing; and Chinese Language courses at International Cultural Exchange School (ICES) are not available to Exchange and Study Abroad students.

Visa

Exchange students are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).

You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202) once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme. Exchange students from Singapore are required to apply for the student visa in person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.

Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/ . International students at Fudan University are required to purchase mandatory medical insurance according to regulations issued by Chinese Ministry of Education. The cost is approx. RMB400 per semester. It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside China (Mainland). Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs. Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.
