Exchange Duration	One semester. Students are encouraged to go for exchange in Semester 2 due to the overlap in academic calendar.
Language Proficiency Requirement	<p>The language of instruction is Danish/English. Majority of the Bachelor-level courses are taught in Danish, while most courses taught in English are at the Master's level.</p> <p>Exchange students at Aarhus University will attend courses taught in English. Students are expected to actively participate in class discussions, study groups and projects. Course Information	<p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 30 ECTS. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.</p> <p>Aarhus University expects exchange students to enrol in 25-30 ECTS per semester.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Exchange students can only select courses from one faculty, and most faculties allow students to choose courses from one department only. 2. Course enrolment is not guaranteed. Accommodation	<p>There is no housing guarantee, but plenty of options to choose from. Exchange students in Aarhus have many different options for finding a great place to live. Visa	<p>Exchange students who are non-EU/EEA nationals are required to apply for a residence permit from the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI) for their studies before the arrival in Denmark.</p> <p>For more information on visa/residence permit applications, please refer to: https://international.au.dk/life/studentscomingtoau/prepareyourarrival/residence-permitcertificate.</p>
Insurance	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. Exchange students (staying more than 3 months) are covered by Danish Health Insurance once they have received a CPR number: https://international.au.dk/life/studentscomingtoau/prepareyourarrival/insurance. </p> <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Denmark. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.</p> <p>Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>
