University	Technical University of Denmark (DTU)
Country	Denmark
Academic Calendar	Semester 1 (Fall term): September to Late January Semester 2 (Spring term): February to June https://student.dtu.dk/en/courses-and-teaching/academic-year
Exchange Duration	One semester. Students are encouraged to go for exchange in Semester 2 due to the overlap in academic calendar.
Language Proficiency Requirement	Exchange students should be at B2 level or better within the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) or a similar level within another language test framework. Native speakers of English are not required to document their language proficiency. Students from universities where English is the teaching language are also exempt from documenting their language proficiency.
Course Information	(1) Minimum workload per semester: 20 ECTS (approximately 4 courses) (2) Maximum workload per semester: 35 ECTS (approximately 7 courses)
	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 30 ECTS. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.
	Exchange students at DTU can choose any course taught in English, as long as they fulfil the prerequisites for each course, and as long as the course description does not mention any other restrictions on the access to the course. This means that there are no restrictions in terms of combining courses from different departments or from different levels (only PhD courses require special permission).

Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. Exchange students (staying more than 3 months) are covered by Danish Health Insurance once they have received a CPR number: https://www.dtu.dk/english/education/student-guide/living-in-denmark#health-and-safety . It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Denmark. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs. Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.
