Course Information	<p>Your home university determines the number of credits you can take, up to a maximum of 30 credits per semester.</p> <p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 30 ECTS credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university.
