Exchange Duration	One semester
Course Information	Minimum workload per term: 9 credits (approximately 3 courses) Maximum workload per term: 18 credits (approximately 6 courses)
	Most subjects carry 3 PolyU credits and are composed of 39 contact hours.
	At least 50% of exchange student's enrolled subjects must come from the Host department. The rest of study load can be subjects offered by other departments. All registrations are subject to the approval of the respective departments.
	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 15 credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.

Accommodation	Exchange students enrolled into one of the undergraduate programmes at PolyU for semester-based study are guaranteed accommodation at the University-managed Accommodation (including the Student Halls and off-campus Housing) for a twin-sharing room. No single room is available.

Visa	Global Engagement Office (GEO) will act as your visa sponsor and send all the required documents to the Hong Kong Immigration Department on your behalf. Please upload a legible scan copy of the visa application form and the relevant documents to PolyU online application portal and send the original documents to GEO by express post. It takes about 4 - 6 weeks to process a visa application. If student's visa application is successful, student will be sent the instructions for downloading and printing the eVisa or couriered the hard copy entry permit to the address as indicated on the online application. Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance.
