

## Information for Students on Exchange

<b>A. University</b>	Yonsei University
<b>B. Country</b>	South Korea
<b>C. Academic Calendar</b>	Spring Semester: End February to June Fall Semester: End August to December
<b>D. Exchange Duration</b>	One semester
<b>E. GPA Requirement</b>	Minimum GPA of at least 2.5/4.0 scale (equivalent to NUS GPA 3.13/5.0)
<b>F. Course Load</b>	<p>Minimum 9 credits, maximum 18 credits per semester for undergraduate exchange students</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Some course offered from each faculty are not available for enrolment to exchange students.</li> <li>2. The course list for each term is not finalised until 2 months before each term begins so please refer to past course lists for reference.</li> </ol> <p>The regular semester workload for full- time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 15. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the <a href="#">SEP Credit Transfer Calculator</a> for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.</p>
<b>G. Accommodation</b>	On-campus accommodation is not guaranteed due to limited spaces. A separate online application must be submitted to the Yonsei Housing Office. Rooms are allocated on a first-come-first-served basis, and it is highly recommended that students apply as soon as housing application opens.
<b>H. Visa</b>	International students will require a student visa to study in Korea. Studying in Korea with a different type of visa is strictly prohibited by the Korean Immigration Office. Please apply for a student visa at your local Korean embassy or consulate with the Certificate of Admission and Yonsei Business Registration Certificate, both to be sent by Yonsei.

**STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMME (SEP)**

<b>I. Insurance</b>	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident &amp; Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to <a href="https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/">https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/</a>.</p> <p>All international students will be automatically enrolled in the Korea National Health Insurance upon receiving their alien registration number after arriving in Korea. The estimated cost of this insurance is around 75,000 KRW per month.</p> <p>In addition, international students are required to submit their travel insurance plan separately so as to ensure coverage during their initial period in Korea.</p> <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within South Korea. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.</p> <p>Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>
