D. Exchange Duration	One semester of full year
E. GPA Requirement	Minimum GPA of at least 3.0/4.0 scale (equivalent to NUS GPA 3.75/5.0).
F. Course Information	<p>Minimum workload of 2 courses (4 NTU credits) per semester, maximum workload of 25 NTU credits per semester</p> <p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 15 credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. H. Visa	<p>Exchange students who will be staying for less than 6 months must apply for a Taiwan (ROC) Visitor Visa. Full year exchange students may apply for a Resident Visa. Students need to produce an acceptance letter from NCKU to the Taiwan consular office to apply for a visa.</p> <p>People's Republic of China nationals need to obtain a special type of visa, Taiwan Entry Permit, to enter Taiwan. NCKU will process the application on behalf of the students after acceptance.</p> <p>Hong Kong or Macau residents who hold Hong Kong or Macau IDs may apply for a Taiwan Entry Permit on their own.</p> <p>For more information on visa applications, please refer to https://www.roc-taiwan.org/sg_en/post/34.html</p>
I. Insurance	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/</p> <p>Exchange students must purchase insurance that covers the entire study period at NTU before traveling to Taiwan, and provide proof of insurance during registration for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Accident insurance worth a minimum of TWD 1,000,000 - Medical insurance worth a minimum of TWD 1,000,000 <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Taiwan. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.</p> <p>Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>
