Language Proficiency Requirement	Students are expected to provide evidence of English language proficiency based on UK Visa and Immigration requirements for the Student Visa application. Students nominated by NUS for exchange at Imperial College London have to follow the advice provided in the "Guidance/Information Document for Nominated Exchange Students". Imperial College reserves the right to ask for further evidence of a student's English language proficiency if that which is included in their on-line study application is considered insufficient. If you do not have any of the accepted supporting documents, please apply for the relevant English certificates before you submit an online application at Imperial's Imperial Gateway portal.
Course Information	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 30 ECTS. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.
