Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.  Course Restrictions: Faculty of Medicine and Health sciences is excluded from the agreement (not including School of Life Sciences).
