Course Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students registered for the Autumn (Fall) Term take 60 module credits (30 ECTS) and are usually assessed by coursework and/or departmental examination. Students registered for the Spring/Summer Terms take 60 module credits (30 ECTS) and are assessed by coursework and/or departmental examination. Students registered for the entire year take 120 module credits (60 ECTS) and are assessed by coursework and/or departmental examination. <p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 60 UCL credits (30 ECTS). Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university.
