Location	University of California comprises a system of 10 campuses throughout the State of California – nine of which offer undergraduate coursework including:

	Research <u>three</u> UC campuses for your exchange studies and rank them from one to three, in order of your preference. When selecting your preferred UC campuses, consult the <u>UC Undergraduate Majors</u> .
	You will be placed at only one UC campus to complete your exchange studies. Placement is done by UCEAP and not NUS.
	You cannot move or transfer to another UC campus after your first term or at any time during your exchange.
Academic Calendar	The majority of UC campuses operate on the quarter system, while UC Berkeley and UC Merced operate on a semester system.

	Winter quarter: (January to mid-March)
	Spring quarter: (April to mid-June)

	Fall semester: (mid-August to mid-December) Spring semester: (mid-January t0 mid-May)

Course Information	Full-time enrollment (12-13 units each term) is required of both US and non-US citizens. If English is your second language, consider limiting your first-term enrollment to the minimum number of units required. Visa	Note: All students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they receive the official offer letter/email and instructions from their host university. Some visa applications can take up to 2 months to process. Your exchange at the host university depends on the clearance by the immigration of the host country. Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance.
