All students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they receive the official offer letter/email and instructions from their host university. Some visa applications can take up to 2 months to process. Your exchange at the host university depends on the clearance by the immigration of the host country. Students will request a DS-2019 post acceptance and apply for a J1 visa. The ISS office will help you navigate immigration regulations and procedures so please review their information carefully.
