

NUS professor to lead global body on infectious diseases

National University of Singapore (NUS) professor and infectious disease expert Paul Tambyah will be leading the Massachusetts-based International Society of Infectious Diseases (ISID) in 2022 as its president.

For now, Prof Tambyah has been appointed the society's president-elect and will support incumbent ISID president, Prof Alison Holmes, in running the organisation until he takes over its leadership as the society's first Singaporean president.
