

Provisional Offer of Admission: Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Requirement

Applicants who are successful in getting an offer of admission will have to meet the Mother Tongue Language (MTL) requirement through one of the following:

- a) Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level
 - Minimum of 'D7' grade for Higher MTL paper
- b) Singapore-Cambridge GCE A-Level:
 - Minimum of 'S' grade for H1 MTL, H1 General Studies in Chinese, or H2 Mother Tongue Language and Literature (MTLL) paper
 - Pass in MTL B Syllabus paper
- c) IB Diploma Programme:
 - Pass in MTL A: Literature or MTL A: Language and Literature paper at Standard or Higher Level
 - Pass in Language B MTL at Standard or Higher Level
(Standard Level Language *ab initio* does not fulfil the requirement)
- d) Pass in MTL-in-lieu subject approved by Ministry of Education, Singapore taken at the Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level, A-Level or IB Diploma Programme
- e) Exemption from MTL approved by Ministry of Education, Singapore

Applicants who are unable to fulfill the MTL requirement but satisfy all other admission requirements will be admitted on a provisional basis.

Important Information to Take Note

Please note that the MTL requirement must be fulfilled before a student is allowed to graduate.

Students who are admitted on a provisional basis must take one of the following courses of action to fulfil the MTL requirement and are strongly advised to do so before their final year of study. If a late attempt is unsuccessful, students will face the consequences of a delay to their graduation.

(A) Register and pass the relevant MTL paper as a private candidate at the Singapore-Cambridge GCE A-Level examination:

(B) Register and pass the relevant Higher MTL paper as a private candidate at the Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level examination:
