#### **Apply to NUS**

Submit an online application via **Applicant Portal**.

Your application is completed upon:

- Receiving an email titled "Acknowledgement of Application to NUS Undergraduate Programmes". Do check your Junk/ Spam email folders.
- Submitting all supporting documents
- Making the application fee payment

An incomplete submission will affect the application outcome.

#### **Track Application Outcome**

Admissions outcomes will be released progressively between March and July (based on qualification group).

Track your application outcome via <u>Applicant Portal</u>. Do check your Junk/ Spam email folders.

#### **Start of Academic Journey**

Successful applicants who received and accepted NUS offer can expect to begin their studies at NUS at the start of the <u>academic year</u> after completing their <u>freshman registration</u>.

#### **Research and Prepare**

Read up on <u>NUS programmes</u> offered. Shortlist your choices and check that you fulfil the <u>programme prerequisites</u>.

# Attend Admissions Assessment (if applicable)



# **APPLICATION STEPS**

# **Login via Applicant Portal**

All Singapore Citizens, Singapore Permanent Residents and other Singpass holders (including International Students with Student's Pass) are required to login via Singpass.

Upon login, you are required to authenticate Singpass to populate your personal particulars via "Retrieve Myinfo with Singpass" for quick and easy form filling.



All **International Students** without Singpass account are required to log in with your **social** account (Google, Microsoft Account, Apple).

If you do not have any Google, Microsoft or Apple account, click <u>here</u> to register your email address (e.g. Yahoo Mail, QQ Mail, etc.) to proceed with the login.


Should you encounter any errors in accessing the <u>Applicant Portal</u>, please attempt to access the portal after clearing your browser cache.

#### Apply With/ As

Upon logging in to <u>Applicant Portal</u> with your Singpass or social account, ensure that you select the correct qualification that you are presenting.


If you are unsure of which category to apply under, click <a href="here">here</a> for assistance.

#### **Declaration of University Candidature**

If you are currently or were previously enrolled in a university, whether in Singapore or overseas, you should apply as a <u>Transfer applicant</u>.



#### **Personal Details**

For Singapore Citizens, Singapore Permanent Residents and Singpass holders who logged in via Singpass, your personal particulars have been populated with Myinfo with Singpass. You may only edit your mailing address, email address, mobile number and marital status directly on this form, if necessary.

For **International applicants without Singpass**, please enter your personal details manually.

#### Please ensure the following:

- Enter your full name according to your Passport or Identification Card
  - You may click here for the name format required.
- Provide a valid email address and mobile number to receive notifications from NUS
  - Do not use a school-provided email address as the email is likely to be deactivated after you graduate from your high school
  - Applicants with valid Singapore mobile numbers will receive SMS alerts for admission updates (e.g. Shortlist for interview programme(s) or admission outcome).

#### **Residential Address**

Ensure that the residential address provided is accurate and remember to **include your unit number** (if applicable).

Applicants with a Singapore residential address are encouraged to use the **Postal Code Search** function for information like Block/House Number and Street Name to be populated if you are not using <a href="Myinfo">Myinfo</a>.



For residential address outside of Singapore that do not have a Postal Code, you may leave the blank empty or input "0000". You are advised **not** to click on the magnifying glass, as it is for validation of Singapore residential address.

# **National Service (NS) in Singapore**

For Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents:

- Select "Not Applicable" if you are not required to fulfil full-time NS in Singapore.
- Select "Registered/ Waiting to be enlisted" if you are awaiting notification regarding your enlistment dates.
- Select "Serving" if you are currently enlisted and provide your ORD date accordingly.
- If your ORD/ Projected ORD falls on or before 2 August 2026, select "Completing by commencement of academic year".
- Select "Exempted" if you are granted exemption from full-time NS by MINDEF/MHA and submit the relevant supporting document(s).
- Select "Contract SAF, SPF, SCDF, RSAF" if you are a Regular with MINDEF.

#### Single Degree Programme(s)

You can apply for a maximum of 8 Single Degree Programme (SDP).

Click on "Add Programme" to add your choice of study, and the "+" icon.





If you have applied for common admission programme(s) such as Business Administration, Common Computer Science Programmes, Engineering and/ or Humanities and Sciences, you are also required to indicate your preferred majors.

#### <u>Double Degree (DDP), Concurrent Degree (CDP), Double Major, Minor & Specialisation</u> Programmes

You can apply for a maximum of 8 additional DDP, CDP, Double Major, Minor & Specialisation Programme(s).

The list of relevant DDPs, CDPs, Double Major, Minor and Specialisation Programmes will be displayed based on the SDP choices and corresponding preferred majors selected (applicable to Business Administration, Common Computer Science Programmes, Engineering, and Humanities and Sciences).

Any reselection of SDPs choices will require you to re-select DDP, CDP, Double Major, Minor & Specialisation Programmes accordingly.

#### **Tuition Grant (TG)**

Singapore Permanent Residents and International Students are to indicate their intention to apply for Tuition Grant (TG). Singapore Citizens should declare accordingly.

For Singapore Permanent Residents and International Students who have accepted an NUS offer with TG, you will pay subsidised fees and are required to work for a Singapore entity for three years upon graduation.

If you have accepted an NUS offer without TG, you will pay non-subsidised fees. You will also not be eligible for NUS and MOE funded or administered Financial Aid and Scholarships during your entire programme candidature.

#### **Financial Aid**

This is to indicate your intention to apply for Financial Aid. You are to submit a **separate** online application for Financial Aid <u>here</u>.

#### **Household Income**

This is for you to declare your household income information.

The University collects household income information of all applicants to increase awareness and assess the levels of financial aid for needy applicants. This has no impact or implication on your application outcome at all.

#### **Documents**

You will be prompted to upload all relevant supporting documents when completing the online application form.

To submit additional documents **after** application, you may do so via the <u>Applicant Portal</u> by the respective closing dates. You may refer to the <u>Applicant Portal Navigator</u> for detailed instructions on how to upload supporting documents via <u>Applicant Portal</u>.

# **Declaration**

This section requires your declaration that all the information provided in your application is correct.

# **Application Confirmation**

Please verify that the information provided is accurate before clicking Submit. To make any amendments:

- 1) Click Back and navigate to the relevant section.
- 2) Click Save and Next to save the revised information.
- 3) Click Submit to proceed with the application.

#### **Acknowledgement Page**

Once submitted successfully, your Application Number will be displayed on the screen.

You will receive an email titled "Acknowledgement of Application to NUS Undergraduate Programmes" within 24 hours after your application has been received. Do remember to check your inbox, including junk and spam folders.

You may pay your non-refundable application fee of SGD 10 via Visa, Mastercard, Amex, Alipay or PayNow through the *"Pay Application Fee"* facility on the <u>Applicant Portal</u> after submitting your application.

The payment status will be updated <u>one working day</u> after the payment has been received. This payment processing time will still apply to payments made on the application closing date.

Applicants must ensure that only one payment is made, as duplicate or multiple payments are non-refundable. Applicants are responsible for confirming the payment status before attempting another payment.

The application is incomplete if the payment is not received by the application closing date.
