


Standardised Test Requirements

This document details the minimum requirements for standardised tests – [ACT](#), [AP](#) and [SAT](#).

Applicants with international qualifications will be considered for admission based on one of the following combinations:



Test	Minimum Acceptable Score for admissions consideration	Requirements
AP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Score of 3 in each AP course 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> AP Calculus BC is a <u>compulsory</u> subject for all programmes, except Law. AP courses must meet the prerequisites of the programmes you are applying for. <p>Note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> AP results from up to two examination sittings are accepted. You may apply with AP courses accepted for admissions consideration. Click here for the list. Applicants applying for Law may take any course combinations listed here and AP Calculus AB. Applicants taking the AP exam in May 2026 must submit the scores within 3 calendar days after receiving the results. <p>New! It is mandatory for all applicants must send their official AP scores via College Board to the National University of Singapore (Institute Code 3720), and also upload a copy of the score report to the Applicant Portal.</p>

ACT with Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Composite Score: 29 Writing Score: 8 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ACT Writing Test is compulsory. All sections (including Writing) must be taken in <u>one</u> sitting. <p>Note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) ACT consists of 5 sections: English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and Writing Test. 2) The validity of ACT scores is five years. <p>New! It is mandatory for all applicants to send their official ACT scores to the National University of Singapore (Institute Code 5286), and also upload a copy of the score report to the Applicant Portal.</p>
SAT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reading and Writing: 600 Mathematics: 650 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All sections of the SAT must be taken in <u>one</u> sitting. <p>Note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) SAT consists of 2 sections: Reading and Writing, and Mathematics. 2) The validity of SAT scores is five years. <p>New! It is mandatory for all applicants must send their official SAT scores via College Board to the National University of Singapore (Institute Code 3720), and also upload a copy of the score report to the Applicant Portal.</p>

All relevant score reports must be sent to NUS through the testing agencies and submitted through the [Applicant Portal](#) by the [respective application closing date](#). Failure to submit your scores will deem your application as incomplete and will not be processed for admissions consideration.
