


Standardised Test Requirements

This document details the minimum requirements for standardised tests – ACT, AP and SAT.

Applicants with international qualifications will be considered for admission based on one of the following combinations:

AP	Score of 3 in	AP Calculus BC is a <u>compulsory</u> subject for all programmes,

		 Applicants applying for Law may take any course combinations listed here and AP Calculus AB. 	
		4) Applicants taking the AP exam in May 2026 must submit the	
		scores within 3 calendar days after receiving the results.

ACT with Writing	 Composite Score: 29 Writing Score: 8 	 ACT Writing Test is compulsory. All sections (including Writing) must be taken in <u>one</u> sitting. Note: ACT consists of 5 sections: English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and Writing Test. The validity of ACT scores is five years. New! It is mandatory for all applicants to send their official ACT scores to the National University of Singapore (Institute Code 	
		5286), and also upload a copy of the score report to the Applicant Portal.	
SAT	Reading and Writing: 600Mathematics: 650	 All sections of the SAT must be taken in <u>one</u> sitting. Note: SAT consists of 2 sections: Reading and Writing, and Mathematics. The validity of SAT scores is five years. 	
		New! It is mandatory for all applicants must send their official SAT scores via College Board to the National University of Singapore (Institute Code 3720), and also upload a copy of the score report to the Applicant Portal.	

All relevant score reports must be sent to NUS through the testing agencies and submitted through the <u>Applicant Portal</u> by the <u>respective application closing date</u>. Failure to submit your scores will deem your application as incomplete and will not be processed for admissions consideration.
