

Supporting Documents Guide for Polytechnic Diploma Applicants

This guide will help you to prepare softcopies of the relevant supporting documents before you begin your online application. You will not be required to submit this document.

You will be prompted to upload the following supporting document(s) before you submit your application. The supporting document(s) for each applicant will vary based on information provided in the online application form.

2.4	Certificate of Merit (COM)	Indicated COM
3.1	Singapore – Cambridge GCE 'O' Level / Integrated Programme / IGCSE result slip	Indicated English, Mathematics, and/or Additional Mathematics grade(s)
3.2	Institute of Technical Education (ITE) result slip or certificate	Indicated ITE (for those who completed Higher Nitec and/or Nitec)
4	Other education score report(s) (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL, AP, ACT with Writing, SAT and SAT Subject Tests)	Indicated the scores (optional)
5	Notice of Exemption from full-time National Service	Exempted by MINDEF
6	Medical report(s) or doctor's memo	Indicated medical condition(s) or disabilities
7	Statement of criminal records or offence	Indicated criminal or disciplinary offence

Your application will be only considered after you have completed the application process. This includes the successful submission of the **online application form**, **S\$10 application fee** and **supporting documents** by **21 February 2023**.

The supporting documents can be submitted via the application form or the Applicant Portal.

Incomplete application by the deadline may affect the processing of your application or its withdrawal from consideration for admission.
